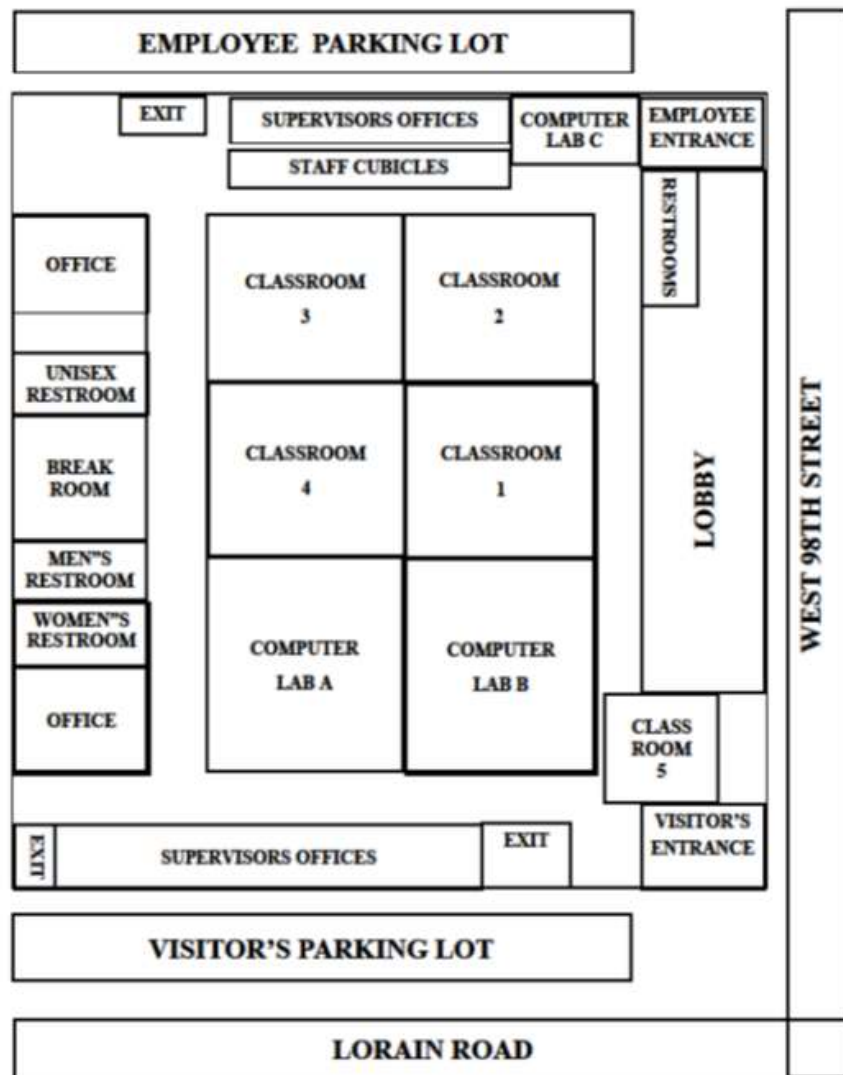

CUYAHOGA COUNTY WESTSHORE TRAINING COVID PROTOCOL

We Ask You Visit Us at a Later Time if You Answer **YES** to Either Question Below:

- Do you have any of the following **NEW** symptoms within the last 2 to 5 days: **fever, cough, trouble breathing, shortness of breath, wheezing, new chills, new muscle aches, sore throat, diarrhea, or new loss of smell or taste?**
- **OR** Have you had prolonged, close contact with a person with **confirmed** COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

Persons scheduled to attend training who are experiencing symptoms of illness (i.e., fever, cough, or shortness of breath) or have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID should reschedule the training.

Program Structure

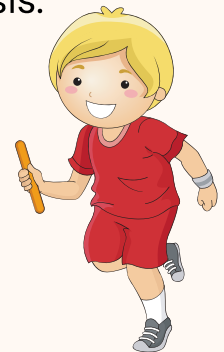

- 1) Missing more than 15 minutes of training content will require you to retake the training complete session.

This course shares strategies for parents who are fostering or adopting to respect as well as navigate differences in values from the children and families, while acknowledging imbalances of power and inequities.
