Cuyahoga New Project Process

New Project Opportunities Regular Bonus and Reallocation Estimate: \$1,600,000

New Project Opportunities DV Bonus, Estimated funding \$5,000,000

Rapid Rehousing (RRH) or Joint TH/RRH— DV Survivors only

All DV Bonus projects must follow Housing First, be trauma-informed, and person-centered

Expansion funding for HMIS for increased system needs

Permanent supportive housing

New projects serving chronic homeless or DedicatedPLUS populations

Rapid Rehousing for families experiencing homelessness



Different Selection Processes for DV and Regular Bonus/Reallocation Projects






Apply for at least one PSH or RRH project that utilizes housing subsidizes or subsidized units from a source other than CoC or ESG

Points to CoC for Specific New Projects expected for 2023

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Expansion Process

Renewal applicant can submit an Expansion application to:


Grant Term for New Projects

May request one year of funding

May request in initial year the one year of funding be used for a period of up to 18 months – not for expansion

Indirect Costs

If you intend to claim indirect costs



Administrative and Indirect

Applicants may request up to 10% of total funding requested for admin expenses

Admin costs are direct expenses and must have documentation including personnel costs

Indirect costs can be claimed on eligible admin and other direct costs



New Project Application Process

Address all Rating Factors:

Experience and System Performance - 30 points total

Experience in working with target population and providing services — **20 points**

Experience with Housing First - **5 points**Experience in effectively using Federal funds

Experience in effectively using Federal funds - 5 points

Housing and Supportive Services – 35 points

Target population and services provided — **15 points**Plan to rapidly secure permanent housing - **5 points**Plan to increase employment/income - **5 points**Barriers to participation and resolution — **10 points**





Application Process - 2

Financial

Cost-effective – costs in line with other projects – **5 points**

Budgets correctly calculated - **5 points**

Mainstream resources utilized - **5 points**

Matching funding requirements met - **5 points**

Compliance with CoC requirements

Commitment to using Coordinated Access and Housing First - 5 points

Leveraging housing/healthcare resources

Project meets leveraging requirements - 10 points

Healthcare/Housing Leverage Points

Healthcare leverage:

- 1. For substance use treatment offer treatment to all participants who qualify for services and choose to participate
- 2. For mainstream healthcare provider, commitment to provide at least 25% of total funds requested from healthcare resources

Housing leverage:

1. Housing assistance from other than CoC or ESG to support 25% of units (PSH) or participants (RRH)

10 points for meeting either (or both) requirements

Complete rental assistance or leasing forms by entering number of units
